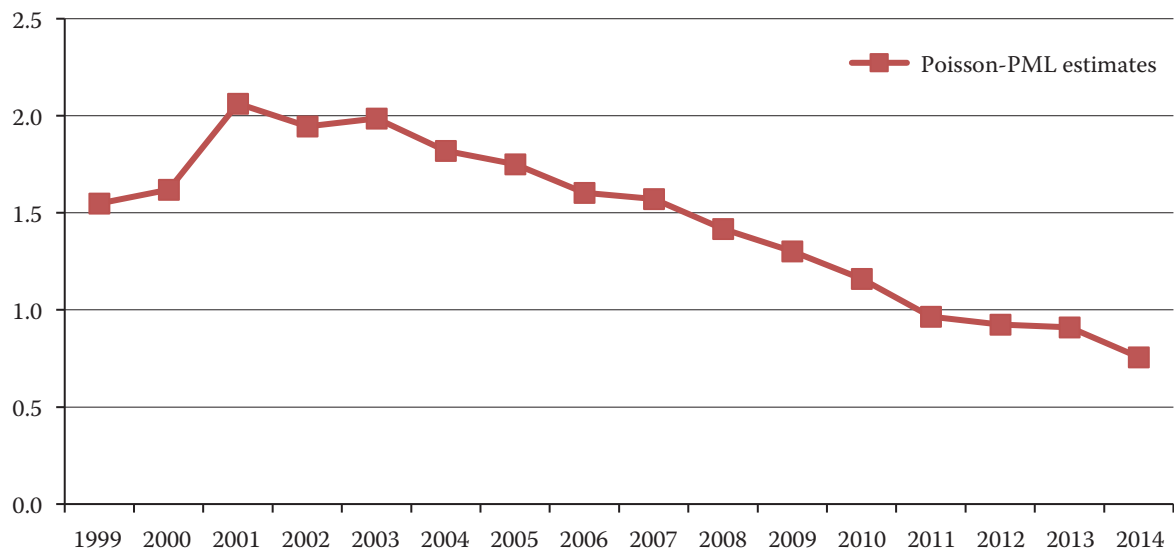


Figure S1. PPML euro effect (1999–2014)
